Day 1:

We proceed towards Lonavala, which is a 2.5- to 3-hour drive from Mumbai.Next up, you will be dropped off at your hotel. You may check-in and then begin your day's tour by visiting the following places:

Lion's Point: Perched atop the Sahyadri mountains, Lion's Point in Lonavala offers breathtaking panoramic views of the surrounding valleys and lush greenery. It's a popular spot for nature lovers and photographers, especially during the monsoon, when the landscape transforms into a verdant paradise. Lonavala Lake: Nestled amidst the rolling hills of Lonavala, the serene Lonavala Lake is a tranquil retreat for visitors seeking solace in nature's embrace. Whether it's a leisurely boat ride or a quiet lakeside picnic, this scenic spot offers a serene escape from the hustle and bustle of city life. Duke's Nose Point: Duke's Nose, also known as Nagphani, is a prominent cliff in Lonavala that resembles the shape of a nose. It's a favorite destination for trekkers and adventure enthusiasts who are rewarded with stunning views of the Western Ghats from the top. The exhilarating trek to Duke's Nose offers a perfect blend of adventure and natural beauty. Kune Falls: Cascading from a height of over 200 meters, Kune Falls is one of the highest waterfalls in Maharashtra and a sight to behold. Surrounded by lush greenery and towering cliffs, this picturesque waterfall offers a refreshing retreat for nature enthusiasts and photographers alike.

Bushi Dam: Located amidst the scenic settings of Lonavala, Bushi Dam is a popular picnic spot and a favored destination during the monsoon season. Visitors can enjoy the gushing water, lush greenery, and serene surroundings while picnicking or simply relaxing by the reservoir. In the evening, you will be dropped off at the hotel in Lonavala.

Day 2:

On the next day, your tour will begin with a morning pick-up from your hotel and visit: **Lohagad Fort:** Perched atop a majestic hill in the Sahyadri range, Lohagad Fort boasts a rich history dating back to the Maratha Empire. With its impressive architecture and strategic location offering panoramic views of the surrounding landscape, it's a popular destination for history buffs and trekkers alike, providing an unforgettable journey through time and nature. **Karla Caves and Bhaja Caves:** These ancient rock-cut caves near Lonavala, dating back to the 2nd century BC, are architectural marvels and significant Buddhist sites. Adorned with intricate carvings, sculptures, and chaityas (prayer halls), the Karla and Bhaja Caves offer a fascinating glimpse into India's rich cultural heritage and serve as tranquil sanctuaries for spiritual seekers and history enthusiasts alike. After which, you will stop at a local restaurant for lunch. After the completion of your tour, you will be dropped back at your hotel or residence within Mumbai city limits.
