

Following are documents checklist to obtain Egypt Tourist Visa.

- **Passport:** Original Passport with validity of minimum six months and minimum two blank pages for visa stamp.

- a) Original Copy of Passport (E-copy will not be accepted)
- b) Attach all your old passports (if any)

Visa application form: One visa application form duly filled and signed.

Applying from Mumbai: Visa application form Mum has to be duly filled & signed by applicant.

- **Photo Specification:** Two recent passport size photographs with matt or semi matt finish, 80% face coverage, white background and without border (Size: 35mm x 45mm).

Please note: Photograph should not be more than 3 months old, scanned/stapled and should not be used in any of the previous visas.

- **Personal Covering**-Letter from the applicant stating applicant's name, profession, passport number, purpose and duration of visit. The letter should be addressed to: **Consulate General of the Arab Republic of Egypt, Mumbai.**

- If onward journey to third country then required evidence that you are assured entry into the onward country that you are travelling to, such as: residence permit· 'green card'· valid visa.

- **Proof of Occupation:**

If self-employed – Company GST copy/ registration copy

If employee- Salary slip last 06 month& NOC Letter

- **Financial documents:**

Updated Original Bank Statements for the last 6-month minimum balance of Rs. 80,000 with bank seal and sign.

- **Hotel Booking voucher:** Hotel confirmation voucher

- **Airline Reservation:** Ticket copy

Processing time: 9 to 12 working days

Additional pickup & drop charges would be applicable as per the location.
